

Concord Township Board Minutes

The Concord Township Board met in the Common Meeting Room December 14, 2015, at 7:30 P.M.

Members present: Supervisor Jamie Ley, Clerk Judy Clark, Treasurer Robert Jacokes, Trustee David Miller.

Absent: Trustee John Pardee

Also Present: Dorothy Cesco, Aaron Losey and Julie Alexander, County Commissioner, Earl Poleski, State Representative, Larry Root and Judge Joseph Filip.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Ley at 7:30 P.M.

Clark presented the board with the November 9, 2015 Concord Township Board minutes for approval. Jacokes made a motion to accept the minutes, Ley supported. Motion carried.

Public comments:

Julie Alexander, County Commissioner gave an update at the County level with Frontier spending 35 to 40 million in the Concord and Hanover areas to update internet services and will be completed in 2020. There is a Frontier League Baseball team that is interested coming to the Jackson Community. There has been an anonymous donation of \$35,000 to have a bike rental with 6 bicycles for the Falling Waters Trail. Earl Poleski, State Representative, gave an update at the State level. Judge Joseph Filip introduced himself as he will be running for re-election in November of 2016.

Clark presented the Board with the November 2015 bills in the amount of \$10,132.37. Clark made a motion to pay the bills as presented. Miller supported. Motion carried.

Reports:

Jacokes gave the financial condition of the township, the revenues and expenditures for the month of November 2015.

Fire report was given by Clerk Clark. 27 runs for October with a payroll of \$3,160.00. Rescue truck had an annual inspection and it found that it had faulty brakes. Rotors were pitted and pads were worn down, the issues have been fixed. The tanker truck also had its annual inspection and they found a faulty exhaust. It is still operational and will wait until the new budget year to have it repaired. The SCBA air bottles have been inspected and those that didn't pass were properly destroyed.

Clerk Clark gave the November 2015 police report with 42 complaints, 1 citations, 14 verbal warnings and 4 arrests. November miles driven were 1,314.

Ley made a motion to accept the reports as presented. Clark supported. Motion carried.


With no other business at hand, Ley made a motion to adjourn, Miller supported. Motion carried.
