The Concord Township Board met in person on Monday, April 12, 2021 for a regularly scheduled meeting.

Members present were: Clerk Sheryll Dishaw, Supervisor Al Cavasin, Trustee Colburn and Trustee Bohl.

Absent: Treasurer Judy Clark.

Also present: County Commissioner Earl Poleski, Ken Wyatt and Representative Julie Alexander.

Supervisor Al Cavasin called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was honored led by Clerk Dishaw.

Minutes from the March meeting were approved by consent.

The monthly bills were presented by Clerk Dishaw in the amount of \$23,791.12.

Reports:

- Clerk Dishaw presented the March Revenue and Expenditure Report for Treasurer Clark. Revenues were \$32,157.83 and expenditures were \$72,353.99. The fund balances were: General Fund-\$271,748.51, Roads-\$29,211.24 and Combined Cemetery-\$43,370.45.
- Trustee Colburn gave the March Fire Department Report. Total of February runs were 20 (4 in the Township, 10 in the Village, 4 Mutual Aid, and 2 Training. Total bills for February with payroll was \$3,005.44. Chief Mosher reported that there were 10 active COVID cases in the area as of the meeting. He brought quotes from two different companies to replace Engine 1 and after some discussion was motioned to purchase the vehicle from the Rosenbauer Company at a cost of \$256,995. The Chief also reported that he was getting quotes to do maintenance on the fire apparatuses. Board members conducted the annual review of the Chief's performance with everyone giving him a positive review.
- Deputy Jacobson was not present to give the March Police Blotter, but board members had copies of the report. Total dispatches for March were 61 with 30 in the Township, 19 in the Village and 12 Out of Area/Back up calls. Calls of Note involved domestic disputes, 4 car/deer crashes, and an attempt to remove a deer out of the roadway which wasn't quite dead.

Bills and reports were approved by consent of the Board.

Old Business:

None.

New Business:

- Spring Clean-up day and metal collection will be held at the Gottschalk Park on May 15, from 9 am to 1 pm. Volunteers are needed to help with the unloading.
- Possible tire collection in conjunction with Hanover Township is still in the works, hopefully with more concrete details in the future.

Board Comments:

- Colburn None.
- Dishaw Asked why the posting about needing a new Assessor for the Township was once again on Facebook, it appeared to be a ghost posting and has since been taken down.

Public Comments:

- Representative Julie Alexander was present to update the Board on her activities in Lansing; its budget time at the state level, she is on several committees, such as local government and health policy, agricultural and industrial hemp and involved in election integrity. She also gave out her cell number: 517-740-9982.
- County Commissioner Poleski informed the Board the County will receive approximately \$224,000 from the State because of the marijuana licensing program. Also, the County is in line to receive \$30 million from the Federal government as part of the stimulus program.
- Ken Wyatt asked when the new assessor would start. Due to scheduling programs and quarantining at the County level, mostly likely won't be until third week in April.

Supervisor Comments:

- Cavasin informed the Board that Jim Cole from JDOT has been traveling the gravel roads in the township to see how they fared after the winter. JDOT will be doing an experimental treatment on the gravel part of Warner Road this year.
- Foam on the Kalamazoo River was investigated and numbers have been received on who to contact if it happens again.

Motioned by Clark, supported by Bohl to adjourn at 6:07 pm. Motion was approved.

Chief's Agenda for March 2021:

Review of runs for the month of February 2021: 20 Runs (4 Township, 10 Village, 4 Mutual Aid & 2 training) with a payroll of \$2,421.00.

Review of bills for February 2021 Operating Supplies – 229.98 Internet/phone – 86.54 Electric – 104.47 Natural Gas – 211.83 Water/Sewer/Garbage – 122.62 Building Maintenance – 600.00 Equipment Maintenance – 1470.00 MIOSHA Requirements – 180.00

Total Bills Paid: \$3,005.44

Fire Stabilization report showed \$172,080.75 at the end of February 2021.

Old Business:

There were 10 active COVID cases in the area as of the meeting.

Chief Mosher brought quotes from Rosenbauer Fire Apparatus \$256,995.00 and Spartan Emergency Response \$356,742. To replace Engine 1. After some discussion on the different pricings which is due to some options to be added as needed and paid after receiving from the budget. Lauer made a motion to purchase the Rosenbauer. Meeks supported. Motion carried. Discussion followed on how it would get paid for. Lauer made a motion to pay \$150,000 down so that we stay at or under the annual amount that goes into the Apparatus Fund. Colburn supported. Motion carried. There will be a discount by paying Rosenbauer in full. That amount is \$2,350.00. The amount left to pay will be borrowed from County National Bank with an interest rate of approximately 4% (percentage to be less when signing – only referenced). We now have a new Engine 1 that will be delivered sometime in the fall. The approval signature on the loan on behalf of Concord Fire Department will be Chief Lloyd Mosher.

New Business:

Chief Mosher reported that he was getting quotes to perform oil changes on all of the apparatuses. Exterior lights have all be replaced.

Chief's review with Clark stating that she was impressed at how he kept us updated and was upfront with us. Lauer said he would give him a positive with review as he has open communication. Everyone else also gave him a positive review.

Board Comment:

Clark asked the Chief if he had the resolution from Tekonsha for helping Consumers with respect to fallen trees and traffic control. Lloyd will get the resolution to her.

Next meeting is to be held on April 21, 2021 at 6:00 pm. Meeks made a motion to adjourn. Colburn supported. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:55 pm.
