The Concord Township Board met on Monday, January 10, 2022 in the Township Office at 121 Grove Street, Concord, Michigan for a regularly scheduled meeting.

Members present were: Clerk Terri Butts, Treasurer Judy Clark, Supervisor Al Cavasin, Trustee Colburn and Trustee Bohl.

Also present: County Commissioner Earl Poleski, Richard Kline, Ken Wyatt, Ted and Megan Meeks, and Deputy Larry Jacobson.

Supervisor Al Cavasin called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was honored led by Treasurer Judy Clark.

Minutes from the December 2021 meeting were approved by consent.

The monthly bills were presented in the amount of \$26,542.74 and approved by Consent.

Reports:

- Treasurer Clark presented the December Revenue and Expenditure Report. Revenues were \$57,207.25 and expenditures were \$20,747.80. The bank balances were: General Fund-\$262,802.64, Roads-\$39,346.05 and Combined Cemetery-\$43,606.54. The ARPA monies of \$87,037.37 have been invested in Michigan Class.
- Trustee Colburn gave the December Fire Department Report. November runs were 15 (5 in the Township, 6 in the Village, 2 Mutual Aid, and 2 Training). Bills for the month including payroll were \$3,733.62. Stabilization fund balance was \$46,076.50 at the end of November. Engine 1 was delivered Thursday, November 18, 2021. Clark commented the 2022 budget was approved by the Township at the December meeting.
- Deputy Jacobson presented the December Police Blog. Total Dispatches were: 58 (21 in the Village, 27 in the Township and 10 Out of Area/Backup). Calls of Note: Worked on 7 ordinance violations with follow-up dates in January; Dispatched to CHS for media post that was determined not to be Concord High but a school in Metro Detroit Chippewa Hills School. Contact was made to that school who was already aware of post; Dispatch had 6 x 911 calls in fifteen minute span regarding a wayward local young woman having a mental issue. Mother showed up and offered her ride to Albion but woman walked to Albion; Assisted the Tempe, Arizona Police department with notifying next of kin about a family member's death. Deceased subject, a homicide victim had family in Concord Township; Assisted CPS on Homer Road on a case.
- Assessing Office submitted Concord Township Report by email. Concord Township's December of Review has closed for 2021. 4 Petitions board acted on which included 2 veteran exemptions, 1 late Pre and 1 clerical error.
- Trustee Bohl informed the Board that there had been no January meeting and that Kilbourne Snow, Planning Committee Chair, had stepped down and that we would need some replacement personnel.

Reports were approved by consent of the Board.

CONCORD TOWNSHIP ASSESSING OFFICE REPORT January 6th, 2021

Concord Township's December of Review has closed for 2021. December Board of Review was successfully held on Tuesday December 14th, 2021, in a combined setting that included Parma Township items and board members at the Parma Township Hall. Concord Township had 4 petitions that the board acted on, which included: 2 veteran exemptions, 1 late filed PRE's and 1 clerical error. All required taxing authorities/property owners have been provided the boards final decisions for continued processing.

March Board of Review 2022 proposed times/dates have been sent to the clerk & supervisor so we can fine tune and notify of the upcoming schedule. Also, March Board of Review training opportunities have been provided to the clerk & Supervisor. Board of Review members are mandated to have training hours/certification starting this year (if training was not taken last year) and must complete them every two years.

Studies from the Jackson County Equalization Department have been received, reconciled and ratios applied. Increases by class will be approximately 3% for Agricultural, 4% for Commercial, 5% for Industrial and 11% for Residential. Residential and Agricultural Land Values and ECFs are complete at this point. Commercial and Industrial will be completed as well as new construction entered and final balancing through the month of January. Taxable value will increase this year by 3.3%. That is the largest CPI increase in actual taxes since 2008 so I would anticipate a higher than normal number of appeals in March.

All incoming splits & combinations approved and received have been processed for <u>2022 tax roll</u> in the order in which they have been received. Our office has received approval for approved split/combo #'s LD2021-02, LD2021-03, LD2021-04, LD2021-05, LD2021-06, LD2021-07, LD2021-08, LD2021-09&10 and LD2021-11&12. All 2022 approved Splits and combinations were due to the assessing office no later than December 31st, 2021.

Fieldwork is wrapping up for the 2021 season with new construction items. Final fieldwork inspection summary will be provided with the 2nd quarter's report.

Deeds, PRE's, property transfer affidavits, and agricultural exemptions received have been entered and filed. All State required forms have been submitted timely.

12/2 – I hit the December ground running by working on 7 ordinance violations with follow-up dates the first week of January.

12/3 – Dispatched to the high school for threatening social media posts involving a CHS. Ultimately the CHS was determined NOT to be Concord High School, but instead 'Chippewa Hills School' in the Metro Detroit area. Contact was made with THAT school, and they were already aware of the posts.

12/6 - Dispatch was hit with 6x 911 calls in a fifteen minute span regarding a wayward local young woman who was having a mental issue. She'd locked herself in a building and began screaming because no one would give her a ride to Albion. Eventually her mother showed up and offered to give her a ride but only if the woman would come home and have something to eat. The woman said 'f---k it, I'll walk...' And she did just that. She has since moved into an apartment in the Albion area.

12/8- I assisted the Tempe (AZ) Police Dept. with notifying the next of kin about a family member's death there. The deceased subject, a homicide victim, had family in Concord Township.



12/7- Deputies responded to a natural death on Monroe St. in the village.



12/8- I responded to a natural death on W. Center St. in the village.

12/12-I responded to the high school regarding more threatening social media posts. These were ultimately determined to be focused on Pennfield High School in the Battle Creek area. Contact was made with their liaison officer.



12/17-I assisted CPS on Homer Rd. on a case.

12/19-I responded to a home in the village regarding a child custody situation. The home-owner and I spoke about options should an ex-spouse arrive on Christmas Eve, demanding to take the children. In short if it happens, stay inside and call 911. We'll help mitigate that situation.

12/21-A box trailer was stolen from a church in the village that contained tables and chairs for special events. A small U-Haul truck rolled into town around 0300am, backed up to the trailer located in a rear lot on the property, hooked it up and drove off. This was captured on video. The trailer was not locked or secured. The suspects then drove to a storage facility in Homer, broke into 10 units and stole items. The church's tables and chairs were stacked neatly at the facility and eventually returned to the church. On 12/27, those same subjects were apprehended in the Bowling Green, Ohio area doing the same thing – breaking into storage sheds. There is no word yet on the fate of the trailer.

12/28- I assisted on a home invasion in the township. An intoxicated exhusband came to town from Hillsdale County and smashed his way in to the residence where his ex-wife has been residing. A large fight broke out between the subjects and family members involving a shotgun, a nail gun and a claw hammer. The subject then fled the scene and returned to Hillsdale County where he was ultimately located and taken into custody. Significant charges against him are pending.

12/29- I assisted other units on Erie Rd. in Parma Township in the apprehension of a subject who fled a domestic situation on foot.



The Sheriff's Department Road Patrol & Corrections Divisions raised \$2774 in our No-Shave November contest! The money was donated to the Jackson Interfaith Shelter and was used to purchase a new hot water heater for the facility. Deputies Laughlin, Wickham and Cervantes were chosen as finalists for best facial hair. As organizer of the event, I was not eligible to win – or I clearly would have.
