The Concord Township Board met on Monday, October 12, 2020 for a regularly scheduled meeting with social distancing rules implemented.

Members present were: Clerk Sheryll Dishaw, Treasurer Judy Clark, Supervisor Al Cavasin, Trustee Jim Bush and Trustee Naomi Carr.

Also present: Kevin Bohl, Ken Wyatt, County Commissioner Earl Poleski, Aaron Losey, Guthrie Colburn, Deputy Larry Jacobson and Linda Haas

Supervisor Al Cavasin called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was honored led by Trustee Naomi Carr.

Minutes from the September meeting were approved by consent.

Public Comments:

- Linda Haas was present to promote her book "The Hidden History of Jackson County". The book is available on her website "jacksonmiundergroundrailroad.com", Amazon and Book Cottage.
- County Commissioner Poleski was present to update the Board on the County activities; Cornell Road Bridge is hopefully in its final process, the county budget has been balanced and the Animal Shelter is having difficulty in keeping puppies available for adoption.

The monthly bills were presented by Clerk Dishaw in the amount of \$28,569.85. Bills were approved for payment by consent of the Board.

Reports:

- Treasurer Clark presented the September financial condition of the Township: Revenues for September were \$30,629.59 and expenditures were \$20,547.43.
  General Fund Balance was \$296,341.43. Road Fund Balance was \$8,454.41 and the combined Cemetery Fund Balances were \$43,024.43.
- Trustee Bush gave the September Fire Department Report. August Runs consisted of 31 total 14 Township, 8 Village, 7 Mutual Aids, and 2 Training. With payroll bills for August came to \$9,249.30. Bills and payroll for July came to \$18,765.48. Stabilization fund had a balance of \$163,644.83 as of September 30<sup>th</sup>.
- Deputy Jacobson gave the September Police Blotter report. Total dispatches were 63 with 23 in the Township, 32 in the Village and 8 Out of Area/Backup. Calls of note were increasing frequency of thefts of motorcycles, ATV's and similar vehicles throughout the county; a domestic assault involving a machete, paring knife and baseball bat; and a driver upset that she got pulled over for doing 78 in a 55!
- Trustee Carr gave the October 7, 2020 Planning Commission report: The Township/Village questionnaire was approved with a few minor changes, the time for the meetings have been changed to 5:30 pm and discussion on acquiring new board members.

Reports were approved by consent.

Old Business: None.

New Business:

 Discussion was held on the PAYS Public Act 33 of 2020 which is commonly known as Pay as You Stay – it authorizes County Treasurers to implement a delinquent tax reduction program for certain homeowners who have received poverty tax exemptions. Motion by Clark, supported by Dishaw to opt out of PAYS at this time until more information could be received. Roll Call Vote: Carr-Aye, Dishaw – Aye, Cavasin – Aye, Clark – Aye, Bush – Nay. Motion was carried.

Board Comments:

- Bush None.
- Clark None.
- Carr Trustee Carr submitted her resignation from the Concord Township Board and the Planning Commission as of October 12<sup>th</sup> as she has moved outside of the township. Motion by Cavasin to accept the resignation with regret, supported by Clark. Motion was granted.
- Dishaw As of the date of the meeting there have been almost 563 requests for absentee ballots for the November election, which 226 being returned which so far is 40%.

Supervisor Comments:

 The Jackson County Road Department are still planning on reforming all the gravel roads in the Township with 5 inches of gravel this year, even though it is getting late in the year; there is a flooding problem on Cornell Road which overwhelms the culvert in front of the trailing park, thus flooding it, more information on a solution of possible will be forthcoming; the process of interviewing attorneys is still commencing and lately there appears to be a rash of people building without the necessary permits.

Motioned by Carr, supported by Bush to adjourn at 6:33 pm. Motion was approved.

# PAYS Public Act 33 of 2020 -- Frequently Asked Questions:

On March 2, 2020 Governor Whitmer signed into law HB 5124 (commonly known as Pay As You Stay ("PAYS")) which amended the General Property Tax Act (Act 206 of 1893 "GPTA") by adding new subsections (8), (9), (10), and (11) to section 78g (MCL 211. 78g (8), (9), (10), and (11)). The new law authorizes County Treasurers to implement a delinquent tax reduction program for certain homeowners who have received poverty tax exemptions granted under MCL 211.7u (such program is referred to herein as the "PAYS Program").

# ► Local unit treasurers **must** opt-in by providing written notice of participation and an approved resolution by the governing body to participate in the PAYS program.

The biggest relief is a reduction in the amount of delinquent taxes as well as the elimination of all accrued interest, penalties and fees, and requires the local units to provide the taxable value of the properties deemed eligible for the calendar year preceding the year the property was exempt from collection of taxes. Under that section, if the base delinquent tax amount (excluding interest, penalties, fees, etc.) is greater than 10% of the property's taxable value, the amount of the delinquent tax owed is reduced to 10% of that taxable value. The obvious assumption is that if a taxpayer is approved for a PTE in 2020, you would use the 2019 taxable valuation.

### <u>Overview</u>

PAYS legislation is aimed at reducing the amount of delinquent taxes owed for those that qualify for the Poverty Tax Exemption. It was signed into law on March 2, 2020.

### Who is qualified for PAYS?

Taxpayers who have received a poverty tax exemption from their home city or township and have unpaid delinquent taxes are eligible for PAYS if their home city or township has opted into the program.

## How does my local unit participate?

Local unit treasurers must opt-in by providing written notice of participation and an approved resolution by the governing body to participate in the PAYS program.
