PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD
ON TUESDAY, MARCH 10, 2020

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF CONCORD TOWNSHIP:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of Concord Township who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the Township Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the Township Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, February 24, 2020**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the Concord Township Clerk's office, located at 121 Grove Street, Concord, Michigan 49237 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 8:00 am to 4:00 p.m.
- Saturday, March 7th from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- Election Day, Tuesday, March 10th from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
